



Debbie Roxburgh started Scottish Country Dancing in Christchurch in 1975. Christchurch proved to be a wonderful environment in which to learn dancing – many excellent teachers and the possibility of dancing 3, or more, times each week. It would be fair to say that Debbie was bitten

by the Scottish Country Dancing bug! In 1984 Debbie relocated to Whanganui, married Paul, and two years later began SCD teacher training completing the RSCDS Full Certificate in 1989.

Debbie currently teaches 2 adult classes and 1 children's class each week. She is active in encouraging new teachers and mentoring candidates for their Unit 4-5 examinations.

Debbie has taught at numerous summer schools and weekend schools throughout New Zealand, and twice taught at the annual RSCDS Summer School at St. Andrews. Most recently she taught the inaugural Teachers and Musicians Class at the 2015-16 Summer School in Auckland. This class was designed for teachers who wanted to gain more experience in working with musicians, and for musicians to learn more about playing for SCD classes.

Debbie is passionate about sharing her love of dancing and believes that her purpose in teaching is to make dancing accessible and fun for others. She believes strongly in learning and practising the basics of Scottish dancing, and her ultimate goal is to impart this knowledge and the desire to dance well in a social environment that is friendly, supportive, and fun.

A concession, child or seniors myki Visitor Value Pack costs \$7 and includes \$4 myki money for travel.

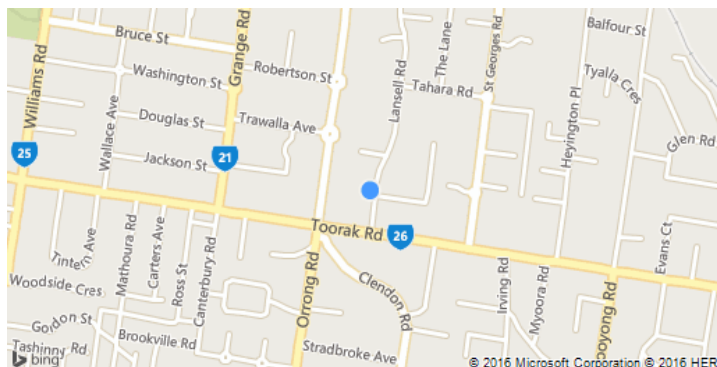
To arrive at 3 Lansell Road by public transport from the city the choices are:

- **Tram No 8** from Swanston Street to Orrong Road (stop 37)
- **Bus No 605** from Flinders Street to Orrong Road
- **Train** from Southern Cross or Flinders Street Stations to South Yarra Station and then Tram No 8 to Orrong Road (stop 37). Then walk away from the city up Toorak Road, turning left into the first street on the left, which is Lansell Road.
